**CAV Training:** If you have taken the training and have not turned your forms in, please do so. If you are on council and have not been certified as a CAV by May

1st, you will be removed. Please understand, this is not an option when it comes to working on council. If this date does not suit your schedule, please check with our other neighboring states to see when and if they have dates available. The only other dates we know of at this time is October 11th in Hollywood, Maryland and November 7th in Columbus, Ohio. We are also in the midst of getting another date from Supreme and hope to have the information out to you shortly.

**Note for those that have attended the April 25 training.** The training had a six month window to get your application in and processed, once you had taken the training. The six months is up on October 25th. It is our understanding that it can take up to a month to get your papers processed. If you have submitted your paperwork and have not heard back from them, then please touch base with Supreme.

As a reminder, if no paperwork is received or in process before the October 25th time-line, then you will have to train again according to policy. We have a May 1st compliance deadline. What does this mean? If you have a council position, GGC office or committee appointment, you are no longer eligible to hold that position if not certified as a CAV. This is mandated by Supreme.
